5 SERVICE PARK

5.1 Number and location

- There will be 1 main Service Park & 1 Remote Service Zone for the duration of the Baja.
- The Service Park is located near Al-Manara Hotel in Aqaba. (GPS: N29° 32.075′ E34° 59.630′)
- Remote Service Zone is in Wadi Rum (GPS: N29° 41.316' E35° 25.586')
- Service can be done only inside these Service Parks.

5.2 Access times for service vehicles

- The service vehicles will be allowed to enter the Service Parks at the latest 1 hour before the entry time of the 1st car scheduled in the timing.
- 5.3 Assistance between FIA competitors still in the race is permitted in all the Baja.

5.4 Fuel/Refuel

- Their no limit on how much fuel a vehicle may carry.
- No fuel may be carried on board the vehicle in containers that are not plumbed to the vehicle fuel system and mounted securely.
- In the Service Park it is forbidden to refuel.
- Refuelling is permitted only in the designated commercial fuel stations; using fuel on sale to the public. Only the crew may carry out this procedure
- The fuel stations authorized will be indicated in the Road Book with "FUEL STATION".

5.5 General Regulations for Service

- **5.5.1** Service and repairs are permitted only if carried out in all the route (including the Selective Sections):
- By the crew of the concerned car
- By the crews of another entered vehicle still in the race.
 - 5.5.2 In the service area, only three team personnel may work on a competing vehicle. They will be identified by a distinctive armband supplied by the organizer (Colour: Yellow) (Article 30.14 FIA CCR GP 2019).
 - 5.5.3 The "SERVICE" / "AUXILIARY" / "TRUCK" Plates must be affixed to the authorized vehicles. During the Baja, no vehicle will be permitted to enter the Service Park unless these plates are affixed. Inside the Service Park the staff charged by the Competitors must wear their wristband (Colour: Yellow) supplied by the Organizers during administrative checks in a very visible way.

5.6 Infractions of the Service and Refuelling rules - Penalties

All the infractions of the Service and Refuelling rules reported by the Judges of Fact or by other Officials will involve a penalty that will be decided by the Stewards of the Meeting and that can go as far as the disqualification from the race.







5.7 **Environmental Mat**

Inside the service areas and the Parc Fermé at the end of LEG 1 and LEG 2 (Agaba Service Park – Saraya Aqaba (near Al-Manara hotel) competitors are obliged to lay under their cars a proper environmental mat to avoid the discharge of liquids on the soil. Otherwise, the Clerk of the Course will award a penalty of 100€ against the car's team.

5.8 **Garbage Bins**

Inside the Service Park, there are bins for garbage. In case of not cleaning of the service area during and at the end of the race, the Clerk of the Course will award a penalty of 100€ to the competitor who has registered the car.

IMPORTING VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

All foreign Competitors must report at the customs when crossing borders. All vehicles must have a valid carnet and a detailed packing list of all spare parts and tools. At every border, a representative from Aramex will be there to assist and finalize all paper work.

It is preferable if all details, including packing lists are sent to the Organiser as soon as possible. The information must include vehicles' details, date and border point of entry. All information to be conveyed to info@jordanrally.com or faxed to the Organiser and a copy emailed to Aramex at tawfeek.hijazi@aramex.com. This will speed up the process of producing the customs declaration documents.

At the Agaba Service Park - Saraya Agaba (near Al-Manara hotel), a representative from the Customs Department and a representative from Aramex will be available for the whole duration of the Event and will check that all papers are in good order before the cars leave the Service Park.

8 HOSPITALITY ARRANGEMENTS

11 SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

11.1 Venue and Timetable

11.1.1 Venue







- The Scrutineering venue is at the Aqaba Service Park Saraya Aqaba (near Al-Manara hotel).
- Layout Diagram is available in Appendix 20.3.

11.1.2 Timetable

- Thursday, September 19th, 2019 between 08:00 and 10:30hrs.
- Cars Individual times will be announced in a Bulletin.
- A representative of the Team may present the car at Scrutineering.

11.2 Vehicles Presentation:

Vehicles must be present at Scrutineering within 45 minutes following the Administrative Checks. A Time Control (AS2) before Scrutineering entrance, Cars Individual times will be announced in a Bulletin, any delay greater than 30 minutes will incur a 100 Euro penalty.

11.3 Documents to be presented:

- FIA Homologation form for T2 cars.
- FIA Technical Passport for T1 & T3 vehicles
- ASN Technical Passport for National competitors
- Original Certificate form for the Rollcage and Fuel tanks

11.4 Drivers equipment:

Helmets, head restraint (HANS) and flame-resistant clothing will be checked at Scrutineering.

11.5 Windscreen:

In case the windscreen is absent due to an accident, at the start of a Leg, the wearing of a full-face helmet with a visor or goggles of motocross type, or an open face helmet with motocross type of goggles is compulsory for all members of the crew, otherwise the vehicle will not be permitted to start the Leg.

11.6 Installation of Safety Tracking System

All competitors must make provision in their cars/motorcycles for the installation of the tracking & emergency system. Installation instructions will be provided in Appendix IV. The correct functioning and installation of the equipment will be checked at Scrutineering.

A deposit of €300 will be collected before receiving any unit on Thursday, September 17th, 2019 during Administrative Checks. Should a crew retire, the equipment must be returned immediately to the suppliers of the units. The units may be removed in the Final Parc Fermé, so cars must not be locked.

11.7 Final Scrutineering

Final Scrutineering will take place at the Scrutineering Venue – Aqaba Service Park – Saraya Aqaba (near Al-Manara hotel). Cars will be escorted to the Scrutineering venue.

12 START PROCEDURE

12.1 Jordan Baja – Leg 1: Super Special Stage (SSS1)

12.1.2 Super Special Stage description

On Thursday September 19th, there will be a Super Special Stage located in Aqaba, with a length 3km as per Appendix 1 "Itinerary". This Super Special Stage will be run in the form of a Selective Section and will determine the Starting Order of LEG 2, all competitors must take part in it.

In accordance with article 18.3 of the 2019 FIA Cross Country Regulations, the first ten competitors of the Super Special Stage must be at Regrouping 2 at 18:55 for the choosing of their starting position in LEG 2.

12.1.3 Finish Time

Only for the Super Special Stage the finish times will be taken to 1/10th of a second to decide dead heats. Once the classification has been established and the starting positions for the LEG 2 have been determined, the 10ths of a second will be deleted and the times thus rounded down to the second immediately below.

12.1.4 Classification and Penalties

The classification of the Super Special Stage shall count for the classification of the 2019 Jordan Baja as well as any road penalties of the LEG relating thereto. These penalties will be considered for the general classification of that LEG and applied the same day.

12.1.5 Maximum time of the Super Special Stage

According to article 14.12 of this SR, fixed penalty will be applied to competitors in case of exceeding the maximum time permitted or not correctly carrying out the Super Special Stage. The competitors will be classified with the Super Special Stage Maximum Time previewed and in case of equal time the order of departure of the LEG 2 will be according to the increasing race numbers.

12.1.6 Reconnaissance

The reconnaissance of the Super Special Stage is permitted on non-motorized bicycle or on foot.

12.2 Jordan Baja Ceremonial Start

- The Ceremonial Start will take place in Aqaba on Thursday, September 19th, 2019 starting at 20:00hrs, it is mandatory to attend by all competitors. We advise the fans and supporting people to be 1 hour in advance as there is an entertainment plan.
- There will be a timecard to be followed at the ceremonial start which will be after the Super Special Stage.
- Competitors reporting late to the Ceremonial start will be penalized with 50€ per minute for a maximum of 30 minutes. Thereafter, they will be reported to the Stewards who may apply penalties at their discretion.
- The regrouping 2 area will be secured. Access is limited to Crew members and Media representatives carrying the appropriate identification \ accreditation.
- The Ceremonial start will be in accordance of the classification of the Super Special Stage.

12.3 Leg 2 – Start, Friday September 20th, 2019, Procedure:

Cars will start from "TC 11" Parc Fermé OUT.

12.4 Leg 3 – Start, Saturday September 21st, 2019, Procedure:

Cars will start from "TC 21" Parc Fermé OUT.

12.5 Finish Procedure







- The rally will finish at "TC 25" Service OUT Finish Holding IN; thereafter crews must follow the instructions of the officials during the Podium Ceremony. From the Podium, Crews will immediately drive to Final Parc Fermé.
- Between "TC 25" and Final Parc Fermé, cars are under Parc Fermé conditions and will be observed by marshals.

12.6 Permitted Early Check In

Crews may check in early without incurring a penalty at the following control:

TC 10 End of Leg 1 \ Parc Fermé IN
 TC 20 End of Leg 2 \ Parc Fermé IN
 TC 25 End of Leg 3 \ Finish Holding IN

12.7 Official time used during the rally

Official time throughout the entire Rally will be that of GPS (UTC time +3 hours).

12.8 Special Stage Timing

- Selective Sections will be timed to the elapsed minute.
- The starting system in selective sections is as follows:
 - The marshal will register the start time on the time card;
 - The marshal will show the remaining time: 2 minutes, 1 minute and 30 seconds to the competitor with hand signals;
 - 10 seconds before the start the marshal will point to the start clock, which is displaying the current minute and second;
 - o 5 seconds before the start (at --: 55 seconds) the sequence will initiate:
 - o 5 red LED segments turn on second by second on the bottom of the display clock;
 - At "0" seconds the LED's turn to green this is the start signal. Starting before this (while the LED's are red) is considered as a jump start and will be penalized.

12.9 Start Intervals

All cars will start at 3 minutes' intervals.

12.10 Time card change during the rally:

When retiring, the crew is obliged to hand their time card either to the next time control or otherwise to the Sweep car.

14.4 Pre-Rally Press Conference

The Press Conference, scheduled on Thursday, September 19th, 2019 will take place in the area of the Ceremonial Start at 19:30.

The required drivers will be contacted by members of the media office team.

14.5 Post-Rally Press Conference

This will take place within one hour after the finish podium and winners' photo session. Members of the media team will be on hand to liaise with the winning drivers and co-drivers.

14.6 Expected coverage

With the Baja representing an exciting new chapter for Jordan Motorsport, we can expect strong local and regional coverage, as well as the international motorsport media showing an interest in how the event takes shape. Extensive written media coverage is expected in both the English and Arabic media with distribution reaching thousands of media contacts worldwide.

Jordan Television and Roya TV will send teams to cover, while a number of regional broadcasters have shown an interest and are expected to attend or receive footage.

The event radio partners; Hala 102.1 and Bliss 104.3 will be based at the Aqaba Service Park – Saraya Aqaba (near Al-Manara hotel).

14.7 Media Safety

We do acknowledge that the Media play an important role in our events and that each member must be permitted to carry out his or her duty in the best possible surroundings. However, they are not







exempted from having to respect safety regulations. In general, this should not interfere with their ability to perform their duties. Nevertheless, safety will always take priority. Such is the open nature of the Baja and this being the first one in Jordan, we request that our media colleagues pay special attention to our marshals' advice and orders this year and take extra safety precautions themselves.

15 MEDICAL AND SAFETY SERVICES

A Medical Centre will be located near Wadi Rum Bait Ali camp

The Organisers of Jordan Baja have developed a medical and safety system based on a hospital network that will be on alert all throughout the Rally, and on the accurate coordination of emergency vehicles and ambulances.

The comprehensive network will provide health assistance to both crews and spectators. The team consists of several first intervention vehicles (FIV) and Ambulances based at the start of Special Stages and other critical locations in the stages.

Four safety and medical helicopters stationed near Bait Ali Camp will provide assistance in difficult to reach areas and be ready to transfer injured patients. Qualified doctors and specially trained assistants are on board every vehicle. Nearby hospitals are on alert and the medical helicopters will fly to larger hospitals in Agaba or Amman if needed.

15.1 Emergency Numbers






